WATER SHOP AT THE CANOSSA COMORO SCHOOL IN DILI

Location

Canossa School, Dili

Introduction

The first water shop in Timor-Leste using a Trunz water treatment unit is installed at the Canossa Comoro School in Dili. The sisters distribute the water to the 4000 children/students of the school and additionally, the water is sold to local markets/shops in Dili. Scope Asia of Timor in collaboration with the Timor Foundation made great progress with the opening and operation of the very first water shop in Dili that is based on a sustainable and environmentally friendly approach:

- Innovative bag-in-box system that is using a special plastic film which is recycled locally
- Vocational trainings about operation and management of water shops
- Education of school children and teachers about water and hygiene related topics
- Technical trainings to local operator performed by Trunz

- 7 Feed pump for bottling/filling unit
