Trunz Water Systems presents mobile water system at IFAT (07/09/10)

Trunz Water Systems will be displaying a trailer mounted and solar powered water treatment unit at the upcoming IFAT exhibition, which has been specially designed for immediate water supply after a natural disaster or independent water supply in remote areas.

The Trunz unit works independent from any energy source. Solar panels and / or a wind generator provide enough power to operate the unit. Incoming energy is stored in batteries and if required, all extra energy can be used to charge other devices. In case of bad weather conditions, the system is equipped with a generator.



The Trunz Water Trailer purifies water in two stages: an automatic back flushing prefiltration system removes larger particles. In a second stage, a reverse osmosis system removes contamination such as viruses, bacteria and dissolved solids.

The system is complete and ready to operate, says the company. There is no further equipment necessary and taking into operation just takes a few minutes. The unit is specially designed to work under the harshest conditions.
